NDIS Disability Related Health Supports Engagement, Registration and Implementation

Effective 1 October 2019, the NDIS will fund 90 new disability-related health supports to Australians living with disability who are eligible for the NDIS.

The NDIS along with the NDIS Quality & Safeguards Commission and the Department for Health and Wellbeing is running two provider information sessions for Allied Health practitioners, existing NDIS providers and non-registered NDIS providers interested in delivering disability-related health supports under the NDIS.
